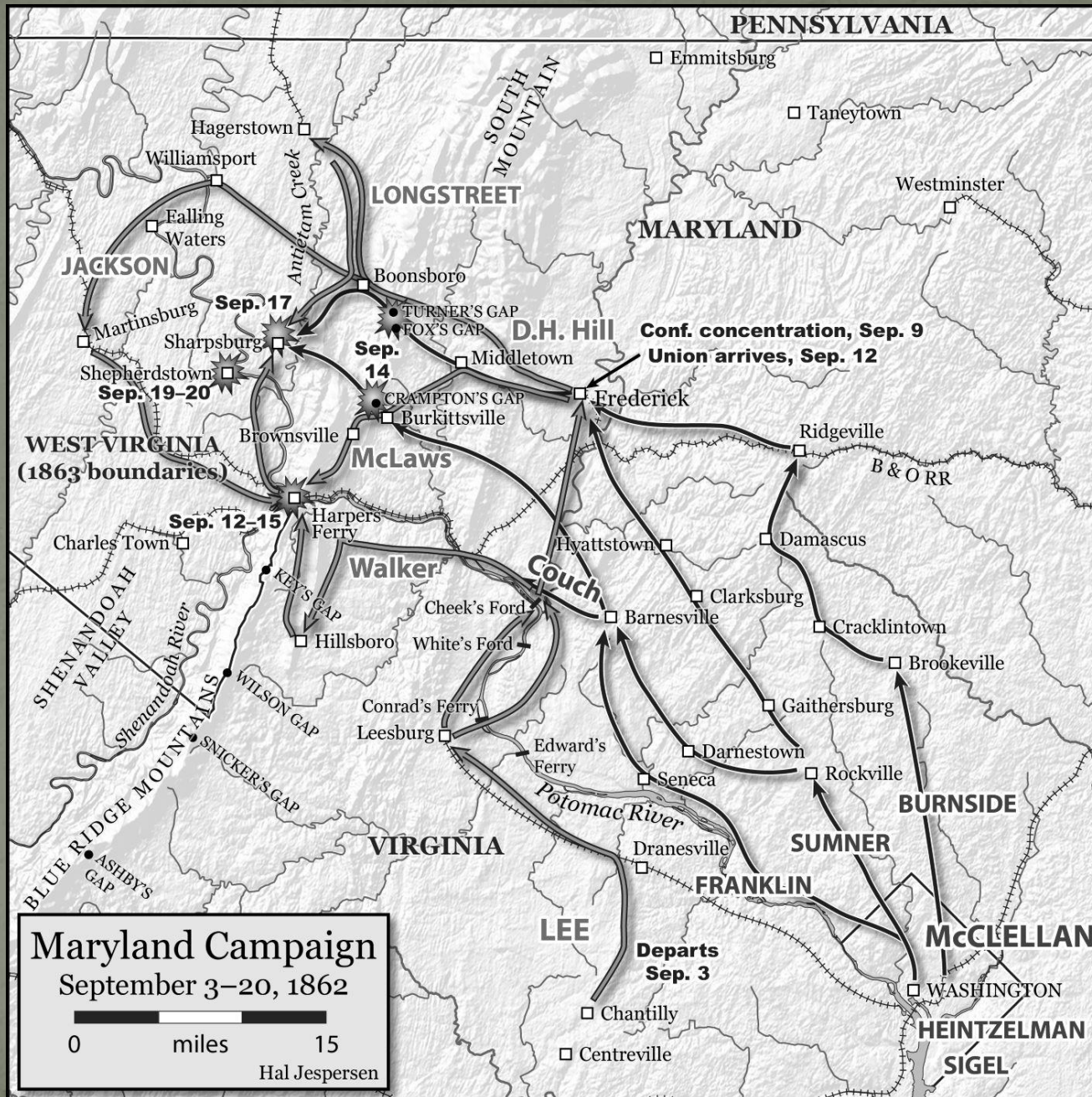

ANTIETAM CAMPAIGN 1862

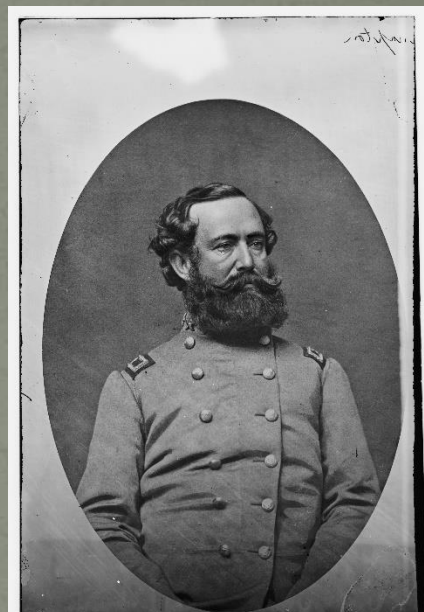
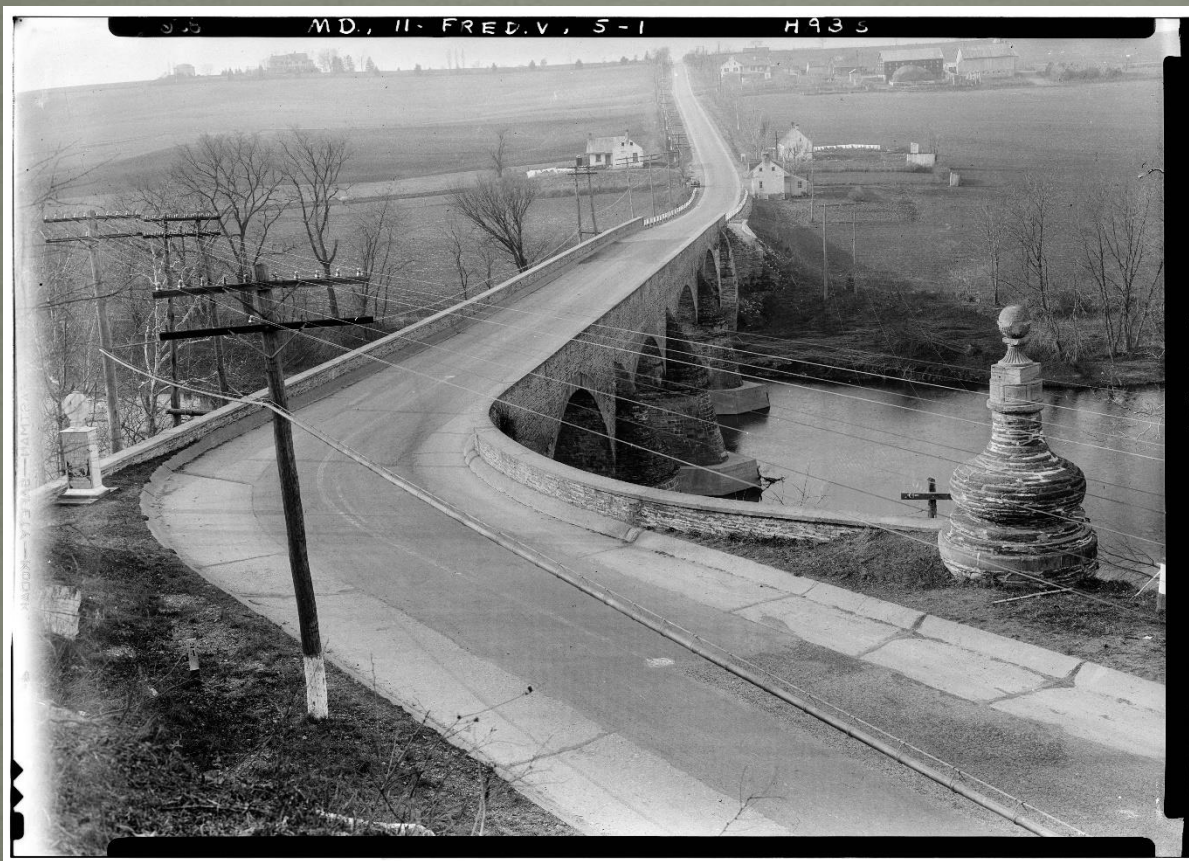
