Stop #1. Car pool from the McDonald's restaurant at **3091 Nutley St.** at **7:20 am** in the **Pan Am Shopping Center** at Nutley St. and Lee Hwy. in Fairfax (near the Vienna Metro and I-66).

Stop #2. First Baltimore stop at **8:50 am** is adjacent to the McDonald's restaurant at **825 East Fort Ave**. in the **E. Fort Ave**. **Shopping Center**. This is at the intersection of **Lawrence Street and E. Fort Ave**.

Stop #3. Second Baltimore stop is at the Civil War Trails Sign on **Federal Hill** (near **400 Warren Ave**.) at **9:15 am**.

Stop #4. Third stop at **10:25** am is at the **President Street Railroad Station** at **601 S. President St.** You can park at a nearby garage (unknown cost) or use meters on nearby streets (\$.25 for 15 minutes). A museum volunteer will lead us up Pratt St. on the **Baltimore Riot Route** (\$3 donation suggested), after which we then will tour the **museum** (admission fee is \$4).

Stop #5. Lunch will be on your own from about 12:00 pm to 1:30 pm. In addition to returning to the fast food restaurants at E. Fort Ave., people can find restaurants near the Inner Harbor.

Stop #6. Last stop will be **Ft. McHenry** at **1:30** pm (fee is \$5). After seeing the **movie** in the **visitors' center** at **1:40** pm, a ranger will lead us on a tour at **2:00** pm.

The tour will be over about 3:00 pm, and you should be back to Fairfax before 5:00 pm.
